MR. LARRICK MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE
SEPTEMBER 17, 2008 REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING. MR. CERMAK
SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. GUNTHER MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE LIST OF BILLS PAYABLE
AS OF OCTOBER 15, 2008 FOR THE GENERAL FUND, LIQUID FUELS FUND,
POLICE PENSION FUND AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ROAD PROGRAM
FUND. MR. KOKOSKI SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION
CARRIED.

MR. CERMAK MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT
REPORT, ROAD DEPARTMENT REPORT AND ANIMAL WARDEN REPORT.
MR. KOKOSKI SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. KOKOSKI MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE TREASURER'S REPORT.
MR. CERMAK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. ANGUS REVIEWED THE NEW BUSINESS ITEMS AS LISTED ON THE
AGENDA STATING THEY ARE ALL SELF-EXPLANATORY.

JOHN CERMAK - QUESTIONED IF THE AMENDMENT TO THE "NO PARKING"
ORDINANCE WAS ADVERTISED. MR. ANGUS REPLIED THAT IT WAS. MR.
CERMAK ALSO ASKED IF THE RIGHT TO KNOW LAW AMENDMENT NEEDS
ADVERTISED. THE SOLICITOR REPLIED THAT IT DOES NOT.

JACK BEDALOTA – QUESTIONED IF ALLISON PARK CONTRACTING WILL
SUB-CONTRACT THE SEWER TRENCH WORK AND THERE ARE BIG DEEP
DROPS IN WOODLAND ROAD. MR. ANGUS STATED HE IS AWARE OF THIS
AND THE BOARD IS WAITING FOR ALLISON PARK CONTRACTING TO
RETURN.

MR. LARRICK MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AMENDMENT TO THE "NO PARKING" ORDINANCE FOR A CERTAIN PORTION OF BYERS ALLEY. MR. CERMAK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. GUNTHER MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE 2008 AMENDMENT TO THE RIGHT TO KNOW LAW. MR. KOKOSKI SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. CERMAK MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE PARTIAL PAYMENT #4 TO SHIELDS ASPHALT PAVING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$275,135.73. MR. LARRICK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. LARRICK MADE A MOTION TO DESIGNATE HALLOWEEN FOR OCTOBER 30, 2008 FROM 6-8PM. MR. KOKOSKI SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. CERMAK MADE A MOTION TO AUTHORIZE PAULA WINNE TO CONTACT BEAVER COUNTY TO REMOVE A SPRUCE STREET PROPERTY FROM THE TAX LIEN LIST. MR. KOKOSKI SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

THE ENGINEER'S REPORT WAS REVIEWED DURING THE WORK SESSION AND IS ATTACHED TO THESE MINUTES.-

MRS. WINNE STATED THE TAX OFFICE WILL BE CLOSED NEXT WEEK.

MR. CERMAK ASKED THAT THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY BE NOTIFIED OF THE RECENT LETTERS SENT TO THE RESIDENTS THAT HAVE NOT TAPPED INTO THE NEW SANITARY SEWER LINE AND ASK THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE A RECOMMENDATION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

LOTTIE RUSNAK, GRANDVIEW AVENUE
-STATED THAT SHE PRESENTED THE SOLICITOR WITH INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS REGARDING THE USE OF FIREWORKS. ATTORNEY START ASKED HER TO EXPLAIN WHAT SHE IS REQUESTING. SHE STATED SHE WANTS THE TOWNSHIP TO ENACT LEGISLATION TO BAN FIREWORKS. ATTORNEY START EXPLAINED THE TOWNSHIP DOES NOT NEED TO TAKE ACTION BECAUSE OF STATE LEGISLATION AND CITATIONS CAN BE WRITTEN BECAUSE OF THE STATE LAW. MRS. RUSNAK STATED THAT CHIEF LIVELY TOLD HER "HIS HANDS WERE TIED AND HE COULD NOT DO ANYTHING" ABOUT HER COMPLAINTS ABOUT HER NEIGHBORS. MR. ANGUS TOLD HER TO CALL THE POLICE. MR. CERMAK, CHAIRMAN OF PUBLIC SAFETY, STATED THE BOARD WILL MEET AND INSTRUCT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT ABOUT THE REGULATIONS.

ERICA WACHTEL, ELM ROAD

-QUESTIONED IF THE TOWNSHIP COULD INSTALL A WALKING/RUNNING PATH ALONG DUSS AVENUE. MR. CERMAK EXPLAINED THAT DUSS AVENUE IS A STATE OWNED ROAD AND THE TOWNSHIP CANNOT IMPEDE ON STATE ROADS. MR. ANGUS ADDED THIS IS ONE OF THE MANY ISSUES REGARDING DUSS AVENUE. MR. CERMAK SUGGESTED SHE PETITION PADOT AND STATE REPRESENTATIVES WITH HER REQUEST. MR. ANGUS ADDED THAT THE BOARD WILL SUPPORT HER EFFORT.

MR. KOKOSKI MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN THE MEETING. MR. CERMAK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.
