MR. LARRICK MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE JUNE 18, 2008 REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING AND THE JULY 25, 2008 SPECIAL MEETING, WITH NOTED CORRECTIONS. MR. GUNTHER SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. CERMAK MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORTS, FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORTS, MAGISTRATE REPORTS, ROAD DEPARTMENT REPORTS AND CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER REPORTS. MR. KOKOSKI SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. GUNTHER MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE LIST OF BILLS PAYABLE FOR JULY 2008, AUGUST 2008 AND SEPTEMBER 2008 FOR THE GENERAL FUND, LIQUID FUELS FUND, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ROAD PROGRAM FUND AND POLICE PENSION FUND. MR. CERMAK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. KOKOSKI MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE TREASURER'S REPORT. MR. LARRICK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. ANGUS REVIEWED THE NEW BUSINESS ITEMS AS LISTED ON THE AGENDA STATING THE ITEMS ARE SELF-EXPLANATORY.

MR. KOKOSKI MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE PARKING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO INCLUDE "NO PARKING" SIGNS ON A PORTION OF BYERS ALLEY. MR. LARRICK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. CERMAK MADE A MOTION ESTABLISHING OCTOBER 4, 2008 AND NOVEMBER 8, 2008 AS BURNING DATES. RAIN DATES WILL BE OCTOBER 11, 2008 AND NOVEMBER 15, 2008. MR. LARRICK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. KOKOSKI MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE A \$250.00 DONATION TO THE BEAVER COUNTY SHERIFF'S K-9 ASSOCIATION. MR. GUNTHER SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. LARRICK MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE USE OF THE VALLEY ROAD FIELD BY SEWICKLEY SOFTBALL LEAGUE ON SUNDAYS DURING 2009. MR. CERMAK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

MR. GUNTHER MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE RATE RESOLUTION FOR THE SANITARY SEWER RATE. MR. CERMAK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.

THE ENGINEERING REPORT WAS REVIEWED DURING THE WORK SESSION.

FRED CHARLTON, HIGHVIEW AVENUE  
-COMPLAINED ABOUT THE CONDITION OF HIS ROAD AND SOMETHING NEEDS TO BE DONE BEFORE HIS VEHICLE IS DAMAGED. HE WAS REMINDED THAT HE WAS CONTACTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BEAVER COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM EARLIER THIS YEAR AND HE DID NOT WANT TO PARTICIPATE. MR. CHARLTON STATED HE DOES NOT WANT TO SUBMIT ANY FINANCIAL INFORMATION TO ANYONE. THE SECRETARY REMINDED MR. CHARLTON THAT SHE PREVIOUSLY EXPLAINED TO HIM THAT HE DOES NOT HAVE TO SUBMIT A W-2 OR ANY PERSONAL FINANCIAL INFORMATION. ALL HE HAD TO DO WAS INDICATE THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN THE HOUSEHOLD AND IF THE INCOME WAS ABOVE OR BELOW COUNTY REGULATIONS. MR. CHARLTON ALSO COMPLAINED ABOUT THE GRANT INFORMATION BEING HAND DELIVERED TO HIS HOME. THE SOLICITOR REPLIED IT IS PERFECTLY LEGAL. THE SECRETARY STATED IT IS ALSO PROOF THAT IT WAS DELIVERED AND RESIDENTS CANNOT SAY THEY DID NOT RECEIVE IT IN THE MAIL. MR. CHARLTON WANTED HIS COMPLAINT RECORDED. MR. ANGUS STATED THAT WITHOUT THE RESIDENTS PARTICIPATION, THE TOWNSHIP DID NOT QUALIFY FOR GRANT FUNDING TO REPAIR HIGHVIEW AVENUE.

MR. KOKOSKI MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN THE MEETING. MR. LARRICK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIED.
